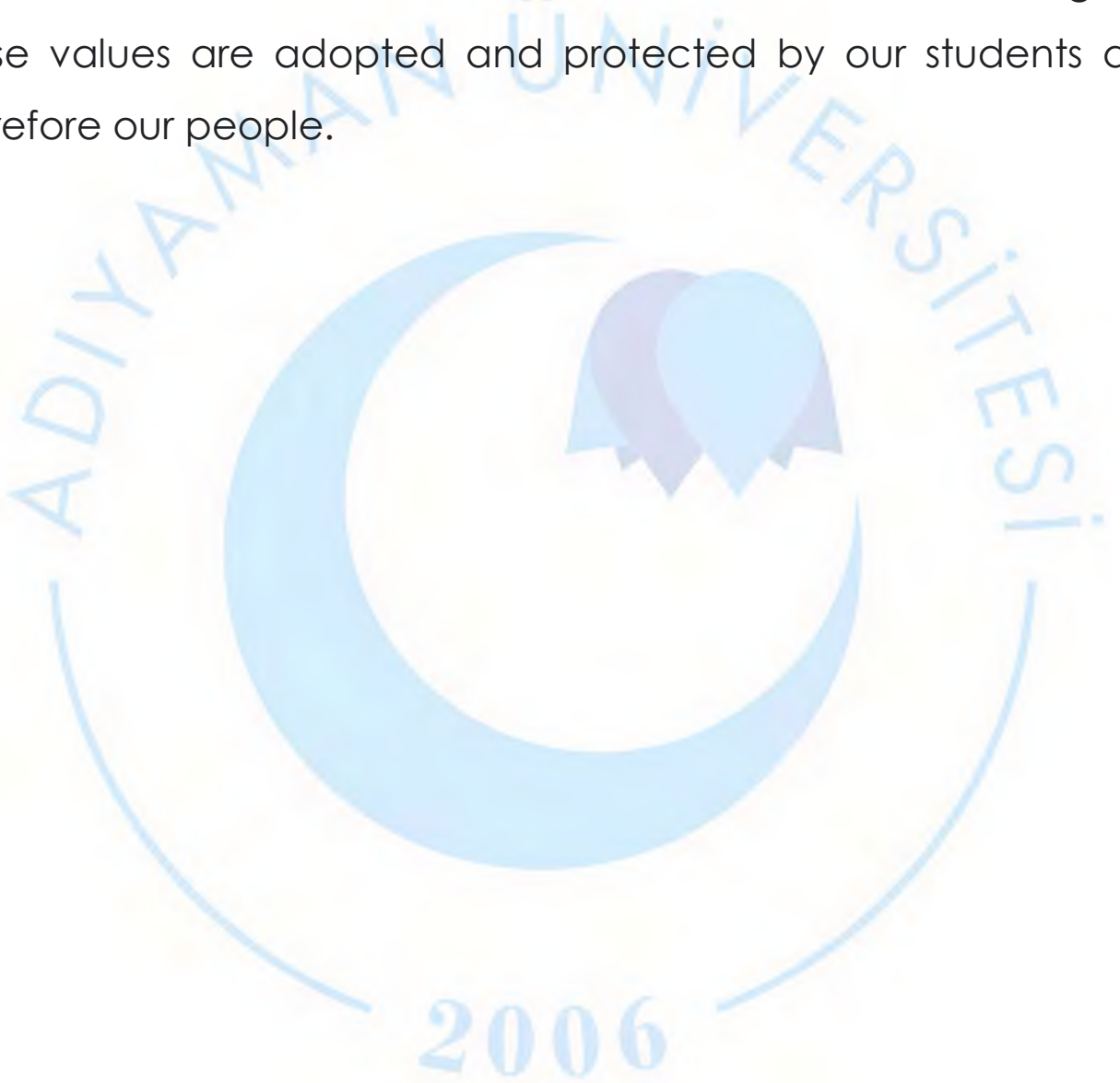
- **Mission & Vision**
